


Meets the Lakeshore 1-800-35-THUME

This is a land once covered with lush forests of pine, beech, hemlock, ash, and birch trees. It is now covered with tradition and treasures for the antique lover's discovery.

The proximity of the lakeshore and romance of the forests brought many settlers to the area. Lumbering towns quickly grew around sawmills on the "Pine Fever Trail." Salt, sand-stone, and limestone were also discovered and mined.

Two great fires swept the area in 1871&1881, clearing much of the forests and making farming the prevelant industry. Lake Huron also continued to create a maritime lifestyle, but sailors also suffered hardships when storms captured and sank many ships.

Many brave pioneers survived those struggles and their families continued to live in the area for generations, handing down both traditions and treasures. From fishing and farm tools to quilts and lamps,
